Ballarat Health signs membership agreement with CTA

August 2010, Melbourne Australia: Cancer Trials Australia (CTA) announced that Ballarat Health had signed a membership agreement to join the CTA clinical trial network.

Mr Marcus Clark, CEO of CTA said, " This is a very opportune time for CTA to engage with Ballarat Health as the State Government is investing in major infrastructure to expand the cancer services at the hospital. This should enable the cancer centre to expand its involvement in more clinical trials which will of course benefit patients in the local area."
