



### **Mobile trial finder for clinicians now available**

Melbourne, Australia 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2015: Cancer Council Victoria and Cancer Trials Australia are pleased to advise you that the Victorian Cancer Trials Link App is now available from the iTunes App store and Google Play. This app specifically designed for clinicians, is an extension of the Victorian Cancer Trials Link (VCTL) website and is made possible through the ongoing collaboration of 45 clinical trial departments across Victoria.

The app encompasses all tumour streams and has a variety of optional filters for clinicians to find potentially suitable trials for their patients, including a molecular target filter. Additionally you're able to register to receive notifications of new trials in your tumour stream area of interest.
